Bright and slightly chewy with a long, dry finish</i></p> <p>Caravaglio, Corinto Nero, Salina, Italy 2015 14 / 56 <i>Ripe red cherries and blueberries, strawberry licorice, with fresh sage and fennel. Full and juicy with a bright, dry, crisp and refreshing finish.</i></p> <p>Malvira, Arneis, Roero, Piemonte, Italy 2016 12/48 <i>Aromas of apple blossoms, fennel & spice. Ripe palate with fruits of yellow apple and Bartlett pear, an elegant body and a soft, mineral driven finish.</i></p> <p>Tabla De Sumar, Albariño, Rias Baixas, Spain 2016 10 / 40 <i>Floral and fruity notes of pear blossom and tree fruits. Full and round palate with crisp minerality and a bright, pleasant finish.</i></p> <p>Nielson by Byron, Chardonnay, Santa Maria Valley, CA 2015 16 / 64 <i>Baked Golden Delicious apple and Asian pear with notes of toasted hazelnut, lemon curd and meringue. Crisp and refreshing with a long, dry finish.</i></p> <p>François Chidaine, Sauvignon Blanc, Touraine, FR 2016 12 / 48 <i>Neutral oak. Ripe Asian pear, pink grapefruit, guava and Canary melon. Rich mouthfeel with fleshy, stone fruit characters and a fresh, citrusy finish.</i></p> <p>Col del Mondo, Trebbiano blend, Trebbiano D'Abruzzo Italy 2016 10 / 40 <i>Stainless. Blended with Fiano.
